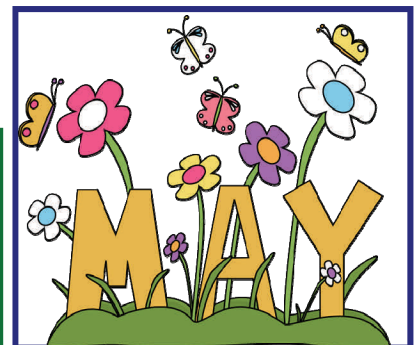

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45pm.

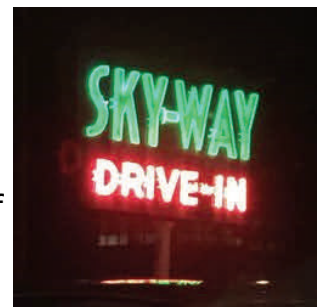
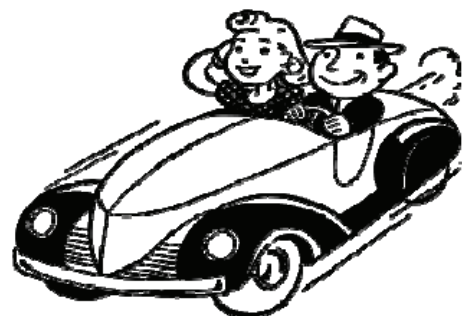

If you are interested in joining us please call Jack at 216-228-9168. Jack needs to pass on the names to the man running this display. Jack will provide directions on how to get there.

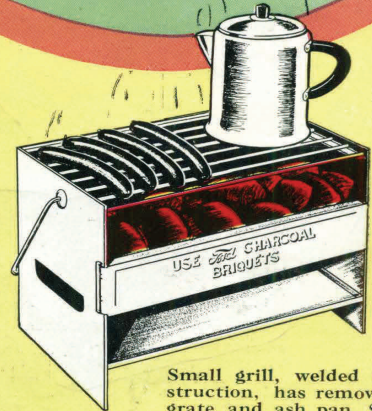




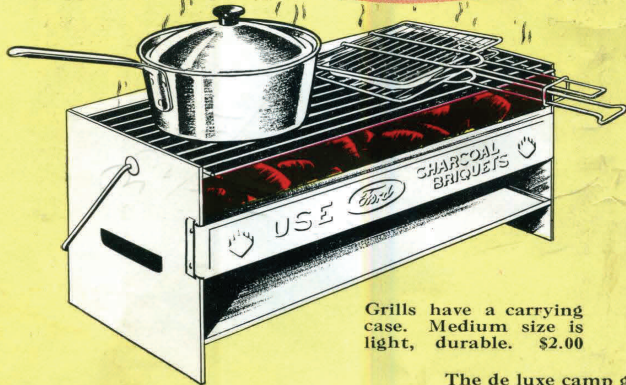
