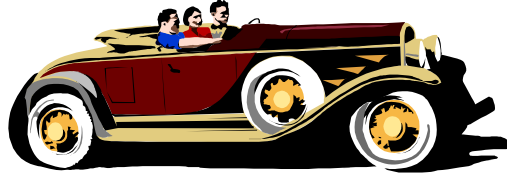

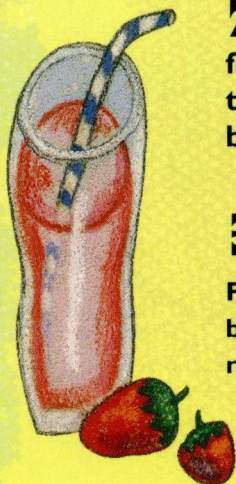

You've never tasted cranberry juice like this before.

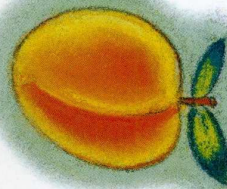
1-1/2 cup cranberry juice
